Pool Rules and Guidelines

Sign-In

Members are restricted to Beverly Crest Community members living in the following neighborhoods – Mirow, Prescott Pond I and II, Saintfield, The Enclave and The Preserve. Members must sign in when entering the fenced pool area.

Guests

All guests must pay \$2 per day. All guests must be accompanied by the inviting member at all times while in the pool area. Members will be held responsible for the actions of their guests.

Pool Entry

Swimmers may enter the water only if a lifeguard is present.

Children

- Children over the age of 12 may attend the pool unsupervised. All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a supervising adult or guardian.
- Approved flotation devices are allowed, however, lifeguards are authorized to deny the use of any flotation device deemed unsafe. A supervising adult or guardian must be in the pool with children under the age of 12 using approved flotation devices.
- Only children 4 years of age and younger are allowed in the Kiddie Pool. A supervising adult or guardian is responsible at all times for children located within the Kiddie Pool fenced area.

Eating

- Food is confined to areas designated by the lifeguard staff. No food is allowed in the pool. All food and food related packaging must be disposed of properly.
- No glass containers are allowed on the concrete pool deck.

Attire

- Proper swimming attire is required for pool use. Clothing and towels with frayed edges are not allowed in the pool.

- Before entering the pools, children who are not toilet trained must wear pool-appropriate diapers with rubber or plastic pants over the diapers– no exceptions! (Products like Huggies Little Swimmers and Pampers Splashers also require rubber or plastic pants).

Conduct

- Pool rules regarding conduct are posted at the pool. Please be familiar with them.
- The Pool Manager or lifeguard has the right to remove a swimmer for inappropriate conduct or actions. Please obey and respect the lifeguards. Failure to obey may result in a loss of pool privileges. The lifeguard has final say on all matters of safety.
- Inappropriate use of alcohol or illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
- The pool deck is to be vacated during an electrical storm.
- Portable radios are allowed as long as the sound level does not interfere with the rights of other members.

Health

Admission to the pool will be denied to persons appearing to have infectious diseases. Persons with open sores, bandages, inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharges or other communicable ailments or diseases will not be allowed in the pool.

Adult Swim

The last ten minutes of each hour is designated as an Adult Swim time. Only persons 18 years of age and older may be in the pool. Supervising adults or guardians may bring children under the age of 2 in the pool at this time.

Animals

Animals are not allowed in the pool.

Parking

Please park in designated spaces only. Do not park in the circle in front of the Clubhouse. Proper identification is needed to use the handicapped spaces.
