At **8 p.m.** residents will sit on their front porch and ***greet other neighbors.***

At **9 p.m.** residents will gather at Ridgewood Rd. and Hickory St. to begin a short ***FLASHLIGHT WALK*** in Loveland.

For Neighborhood Watch Groups (NWG) to maintain their active status “the group must meet a minimum of once a year”. About half of Loveland blocks are now signed up. We would like to see all block captains and as many residents as possible from throughout Loveland coming together for this event.

“The basic purpose of the NWG program is to reunite the neighborhoods into close, friendly groups who watch over each other, work on neighborhood problems together and report suspicious activity to 911” (Omaha Police Dept.)

The walk route will go north from the intersection of Ridgewood Rd and Hickory to Woolworth, West on Woolworth to 83rd St., South on 83rd to Hickory, and back to the start (less than one mile).

Voluntary cash or check **donations** to support the work of the association will be welcome at this time.

Police/Fire units will be on hand at 9 p.m. to support NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH.
