## NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

Our neighborhood watch program is a group of neighbors who are willing to communicate with each other and pass along crime and non-crime related neighborhood information. We have block captains on most, but not all streets. The block captains are responsible for distributing any crime related information forwarded by the security director and sharing it with their neighbors. Learn neighbors names and be able to identify their vehicles and other vehicles usually in you neighborhood. Our deputies are not going to be able to identify a strange car as quickly as a resident. Contact the security director for "RF" stickers for your car rear windows. It is up to all of us to watch out for each other and keep our neighborhood safe and crime-free.

### ***Each neighbor in our community can:***

- Make sure that your porch/street light is replaced and left on at night – dark houses, especially a string of them – invite crime.
- Let your block captain know when you will be on vacation/away from home so that they can keep an eye on your house. Leave contact information with your block captain in case of an emergency (fire, burglary, etc) while you are away.
- Inform police and HOA of any suspicious activity (see contact info below).
- Help identify any existing block problems or concerns and bring them to the attention of your block captain.

### **Suspicious/Criminal Activity:**

If you witness a crime or suspicious activity **in progress**, please call the Constable's office 281-376-3472 (or 911) and give as much detail about the person/situation as possible.

Please report any suspicious or criminal activity to your block captain or Jude Wiggins, Security Director. She will notify other block captains as appropriate as well as the Constable's office.

All information reported will be held in the strictest confidence.
