

## LOUISVILLE SUZUKI STRING ASSOCIATION SUMMER INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

In order to assist qualified students to enhance their private Suzuki lessons with the Institute experience, the Louisville Suzuki String Association offers three types of scholarships:

1. The **Peggy Mastropaolo Scholarship**, in honor of one of our past Institute Directors: One Scholarship of \$175 will be awarded on the basis of merit to a cello or viola student. This year's winner will perform on one of the daily recitals.
2. The **Michael C. Cherry Scholarship**, in honor of a prior Suzuki student who died at age 24 in December 1996: One Scholarship of \$175 will be awarded on the basis of merit to a viola or violin student. This year's winner will perform on one of the daily recitals.
3. **Financial Aid Scholarships**: Some funds are available to supplement Institute fees for qualified financially needy Suzuki students. Please be aware that financial aid funds are limited, and are based on School Lunch Program guidelines.

**Families of all Scholarship recipients will be expected to contribute 5 hours of volunteer time to assist as needed during the Summer Institute.**

For Scholarships based on merit please submit:

- (1) one recommendation from someone familiar with your instrumental ability;
- (2) a letter from the Applicant outlining musical accomplishments to date and future musical plans;
- (3) a cassette tape or CD with two three-minute or longer pieces performed by the Applicant. One piece should be fast and technically challenging, the other should be slower and more melodic to demonstrate tone quality. Accompanist is not necessary;
- (4) the applicable application form;
- (5) the registration fee.

For Financial Aid Scholarships: Please submit:

- (1) the applicable application form;
- (2) a photocopy of the first page of your most recently filed IRS 1040 form;
- (3) the registration fee.

To insure a place in our Institute, mail the appropriate materials and registration fee as soon as possible. Your request will not be considered until we have received all of the required information. The deadline is May 13th. You will be notified before the Institute begins as to your merit or financial award. If you decide that you are unable to attend, the registration fee will be refunded.
