

RESOLUTION 07-01
No Parking Snow Emergency

WHEREAS: the need still exists to facilitate the clearing of township Roadways during heavy snow fall by all allowing for the unrestricted Movement of snow removal equipment and it is determined the Public Safety and Welfare would be served by such regulation and does not conflict with the uniform traffic act RC Chapter 4511 and 4513 plus 505.17.

WHEREAS: a need exists to maintain unrestricted flow of traffic during heavy snowfalls.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BLENDON TOWNSHIP, THAT

- (1) Vehicles shall not be parked on the streets of Blendon Township at such times as the Franklin County Sheriff's Office indicates a Level 1-2-3 snow emergency.
- (2) All vehicles parked on the streets of Blendon Township must be moved by owners or operators within two (2) hours after dissemination of information that weather conditions prohibiting parking as declared under paragraph one (1) hereof, exists. Any vehicle parked in violation of these prohibitions shall be subject to removal by authorized agents of Blendon Township at the order of the Chief of Police or the Chairman of Board of Trustees and then shall subject the owner or operator to costs of towing and storage as provided herein.
- (3) It shall be the responsibility of the owners or operators of vehicles to ascertain whether or not the weather conditions or the declared emergency requires the removal of their vehicles from the streets or areas designated in paragraph (1) and (2).
- (4) Any vehicle removed by authorized agents of Blendon Township shall be removed to a motor vehicle impound lot as designated by the Chief of Police or the Chairman of Board of Trustees. The Police Department shall maintain records of motor vehicles removed and their locations.
- (5) Whoever violates the provisions of this Resolution is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Fines levied and collected under this Resolution shall be paid into the Blendon Township General Fund in accordance with Section 505.17 Ohio Revised Code.
