The 109th Precinct wants your help in combating vehicle break-ins. Vehicle break-ins are a city wide problem, but by educating the residents



of our community we can deter these crimes. Don't become a victim, follow these crime prevention tips listed below.

DO NOT LEAVE UNATTENDED PROPERTY IN YOUR PARKED VEHICLE

1. Your vehicle is **not a secure** place for storage of personal property. Do not place packages on the rear seat of your car and leave them unattended.
2. **DO NOT LEAVE CASH OR CREDIT CARDS** in a parked vehicle.
3. If you do not leave property inside your parked vehicle the chances of getting broken into are drastically reduced.
4. Do not store any valuables in your auto. (**G.P.S. systems, laptop computers, jewelry, etc.**)
5. **DO NOT LEAVE SUCTION CUPS ON WINDSHIELD.**
6. Always try to leave your auto parked in an area where there is plenty of lighting.
7. Protect your rims and tires by getting **lug nut locks**.
8. Activate any security alarms.
9. **If you see someone suspicious call 911, you may remain anonymous when calling.**
