Dear Residents,

Are your shutters faded? If your home is less than 5 years old and your shutters were put on by Complete Residential, then they come with a 5 year fade warranty. All you have to do is call Complete Residential at 706-868-8925 and they will replace the faded ones free of charge. There might be an installation fee if you choose to have them install the shutters.

There have been incidents of cars riding up on the grass at our entrance and at the clubhouse area. Please be aware that part of the HOA dues every homeowner in Woodlief pays goes toward the maintenance of these common areas. If you see anyone riding up on the grass, please take down their license plate number and either turn it in to the HOA or call the non-emergency number to the Columbia County Sheriff's office to report vandalism. 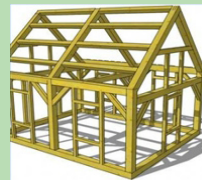

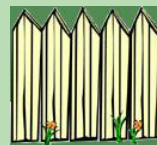

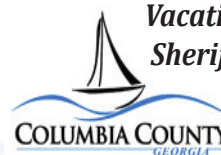
