

**Woodlief covenants** state all trash cans should be stored out of sight, not in front or beside your house. Please keep your trash can out of sight where it cannot be seen from the street except on pick up days.



**Woodlief covenants** state no cars are to be parked on the street with the exception of short term visitors. Please keep all cars in the driveway or garage. Cars parked on the street obstruct sight and block emergency vehicle access.



**Woodlief covenants and Columbia County ordinances** state no atv's or dirt bikes allowed on neighborhood streets, green spaces, power easements or common areas. Please report any activity to the Columbia County Sheriff's Office.



**Please watch for vehicles "mud bogging" in our common areas or the new section.** There has been at least two reports of persons driving a gold colored truck and a black Explorer in the wooded area of the new section and in the common areas. The Sheriff's Office has been notified and they have one tag number. They have asked us to call them if it happens again. Please be alert and call if you see anything. They are causing damage to our property as well as trespassing.
