Commissioners' Report:

Utilities- Frank reported he had multiple conversations with a resident regarding MSD on the drainage issue in his back yard, and he contacted LG&E about a street light out on Halifax.

Public Health & Safety- Darren reported 4 Citizen Contact, 9 Written/ Verbal Warnings, and 26 Citations. A car was towed from Bay Garden area for abandonment. He toured the area for parking violation and safety concerns. Talked with unemployment bureau concerning the past due bill, and was watching for solicitors and verified police billing.

Property Maintenance- Glenn reported open space were mowed for the last time this year and leaf removal is in progress. A report was sent to Steve on yards being mowed to collect fee.

Road Maintenance- Krystal reported she contacted Rosco to get a time estimate for the Treis condos road repair project. He said it depends on the weather as it takes two-three days to complete. A resident reported that the Middlesex and Northumberland sign is missing so she will contact Saf-ti-co to get it replaced and a solicitation sign on Westport entrance.
