

GARBAGE CANS

Garbage cans/containers/bags should not be placed at the curb more than 24 hours prior to scheduled pickup. All cans/containers should be removed from the curb by midnight. For more information or to report a missed pick-up, call Utility Billing at 541-0711. (Section 11-104)



PORTABLE STORAGE UNITS

Portable Storage Units (PSUs) should not exceed 15 calendar days per siting on a residential lot, with a maximum of two (2) sitings per calendar year. The only exception is that during permitted construction activity, a PSU may remain on the lot in the rear or side yard. (Section 18-1530.21)

ANIMALS

NUISANCES, FEEDING, DEFECATION

Residents must not allow animals to bark, whine, howl, or make noises in a repeated manner which creates a public nuisance. Animals must not defecate on any public or private property unless the fecal matter is removed. Residents may not feed any wild animals. (Section 5-202) (Section 5-211)

Tips For Maintaining Your Residential Property In Compliance With City Codes



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The following is a list of some common code violations. This is only to be used as a guide. For a complete listing of City Ordinances, you can access the City's website at www.pinellas-park.com

COMMERCIAL/RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

The only permitted commercial-type vehicle allowed is a van, pickup truck or similar vehicle that has not been altered in any way.

Only one recreational vehicle shall be permitted within the front yard or secondary front yard.
(Section 18-1530.15)

INOPERABLE/ABANDONED VEHICLES

An inoperable/abandoned vehicle is one that does not display a current license tag and/or is not equipped with all working parts required to legally and safely operate on public streets, or one that cannot be driven under its own power. (Section 12-302)

MAINTENANCE OF STRUCTURES

All structures should be maintained, kept structurally sound and have no evidence of deterioration. A structure is anything constructed or erected with a fixed location on the ground, including but not limited to buildings, sheds, fences, etc. (Section 12-109)



OUTDOOR STORAGE

Equipment, household wares, furnishings, etc. that would not ordinarily be used outdoors cannot be stored outdoors. Such items must be stored inside a completely enclosed structure. With an active City utility account, unwanted bulk items may be brought to the curb on your regular garbage day for pick-up & disposal at no additional charge (a separate truck may be sent). (Section 18-1530.11)

DISCARDED APPLIANCES

Discarded/abandoned refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers or other airtight appliances may not be stored outside. With an active City utility account, appliances may be brought to the curb on your regular garbage day for pick-up & disposal at no additional charge (a separate truck may be sent). Before bringing to the curb, appliances must have the door removed, be completely enclosed in a crate, or be securely locked from the outside by means of a lock and chain or other secure locking device. (Section 16-106) (Section 18-1530.11)

YARD MAINTENANCE

No residential property within the City limits shall be overgrown with grass, weeds, or vegetation to a height exceeding 8 inches. Maintenance of all public rights-of-way is the responsibility of the abutting resident. All vegetation and trees are to be trimmed so as not to impair vision or obstruct travel on City roadways.
(Section 12-104)

YARD SALES/GARAGE SALES

Residents may have yard/garage sales no more than two (2) times (per address) during any six (6) month period. Sales can be for up to three (3) consecutive days, during daylight hours. Signs may not be attached to utility poles or placed in any right-of-way area. (Section 18-1530.6)



MAINTENANCE OF SWIMMING POOLS & FENCES

Swimming pools must be maintained and kept clean so they do not become stagnant. Swimming pools shall be enclosed by a 6 foot wood, masonry, or chain link fence, a screened enclosure, or other structure to obstruct access. All gates/openings shall be securely closed and latched at all times.
(Section 12-101) (Section 18-1530.4)
