T-shirts will be given to the first 70 finishers along with refreshments and free bottled water.*

**Community Clean Up Day will be May 31st, 2014 from 7 am. To 12 noon. There will be two dumpsters located; (1) Stevenswood & Lauri, and (2) 8546 Stevenswood Road. If anyone needs to be provided with a list of Acceptable, Prohibited, or Restricted items, please contact an officer of the SIA association for a printed copy or access the Stevenswood.org website. There will be no dumpster stationed on Courtleigh Drive. Also, there will be no Community Clean Up Day scheduled in October. The association expenses are increasing, but the community participation in the clean-up and in becoming members of the association have weighed heavily on this decision.**



**The association wishes to thank the 14 individuals who took the incentive to purchase the recycle bins from Mack Randolph. It is hopeful that those individuals and many more of the community members will take the time to separate their trash for the Wednesday morning Baltimore County Recycling pickup.
