SOLICITATION

We have a non-solicitors ordinance which by law cannot prevent religious organizations or people running for elected office to knock on your door. They can be ignored. You can place a No Solicitation sign by your door. If a person knocks anyway ask for a business card or try to get the persons name and company affiliation. Then call Metro Police 8th District at 502-574-2111 option 8 and make them aware of the problem. Also call or email that info to the city line and the city attorney will contact them.

Utilities & Sanitation

Fall is coming and that means falling leaves. Please remember to use biodegradable bags, or a container with yard waste only items. This a Metro Louisville ordinances that could result in fines.

Falling leaves, if not collected can and will prevent proper drainage, and cause flooding in the city. Please bag or mulch with your mower. Remember to bind sticks and branches. (Use string, rope, duck tape). Waste Management will not pick up yard waste of any sort that is just piled up in front of your home.

Waste Management will not pick up mattresses unless it's enclosed in plastic, due to the bed bug problem in the Metro area. This is a Metro Ordinance.
