

North Hills Civic Association
Minutes of the Annual Meeting held at Mt. Pleasant High School
April 22, 2015

President Mary Anne Korant opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. and introduced officers and board members. 15 residents signed the attendance list.

Minutes of the April 16, 2014 were approved.

As Treasurer Maureen Bower was unable to attend, President Korant presented her report. The Association had \$3147.01 in expenses. NHCA paid \$2620 for snow removal and collected \$3589 in dues. While some transactions had not been resolved, as of 3/30/2014, the Association's accounts totaled \$14,217.91.

President Korant thanked everyone who helped with the association's work during the past year, including the block captains and board members, who are Maureen Bowser (treasurer), John Stevenson (secretary), Teri Lovell (vice president), and trustees Valerie Cesna, Marilyn Green, and Gigi Kelleher. Valerie was thanked for her service. Her term ended following the meeting.

As a volunteer organization, nominations were taken from the floor for elected offices. The members elected these officers and trustees for the 2015-2017 term:

Community Issues

After hearing the Board's recommendations, residents voted for 2015 household dues to remain at current rates: \$30 for residents on NHCA-plowed streets and to \$8 for those on streets plowed by the State.

Valerie Censa reported on traffic issues.

To help prevent identity theft, NHCA will sponsor a 3-hour shredding event in the Mt. Pleasant High School parking lot. Dues-paying households will be able to shred three boxes of record. All others will need to pay \$15 per box.

Marilyn Green wants to organize a group to pick up trash along the road. She will draft an email for John Stevenson to distribute to the email list.

Rep. Charles Potter and Councilman John Cartier attended and spoke briefly. Both were available to answer questions following the meeting.
