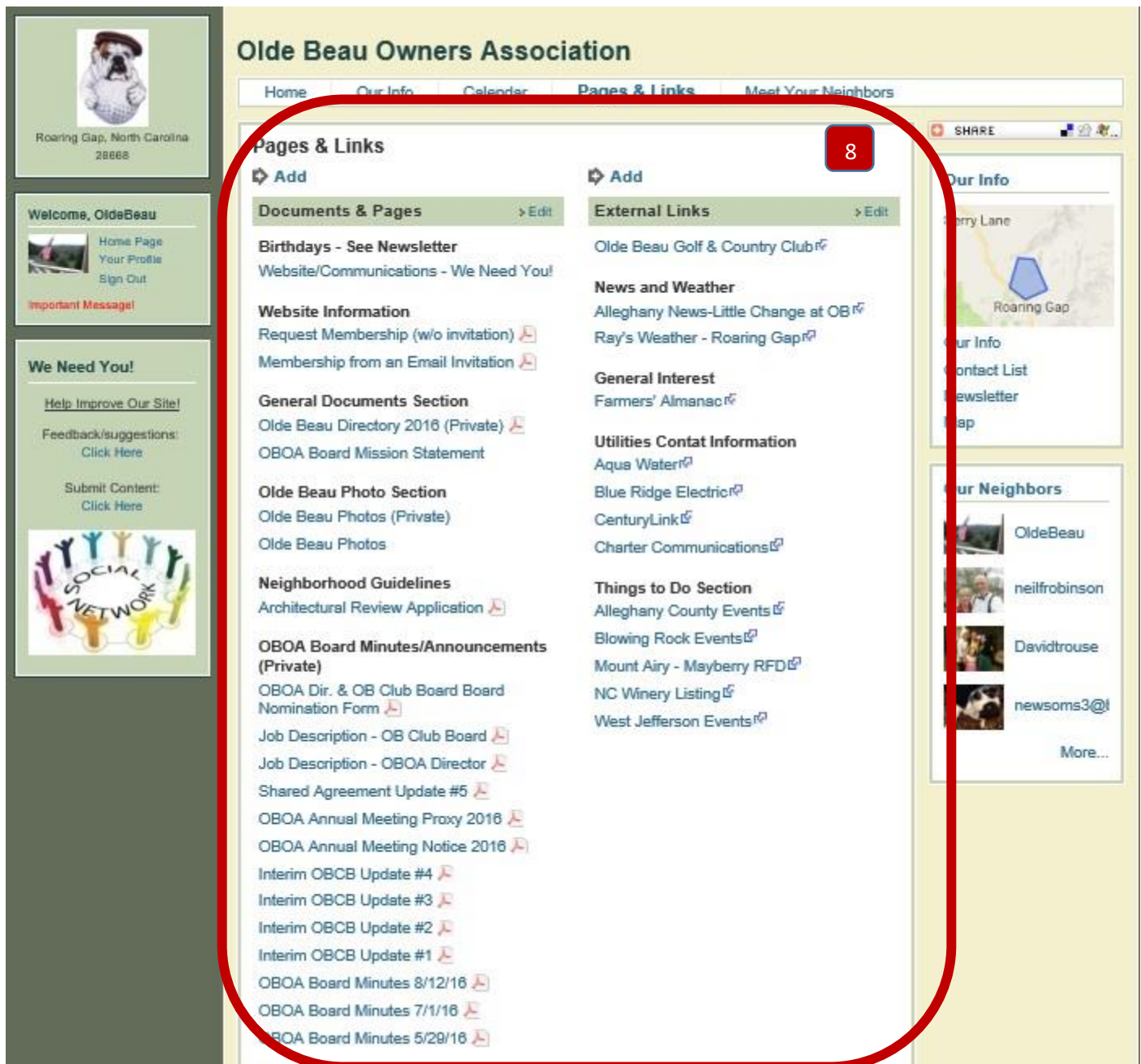

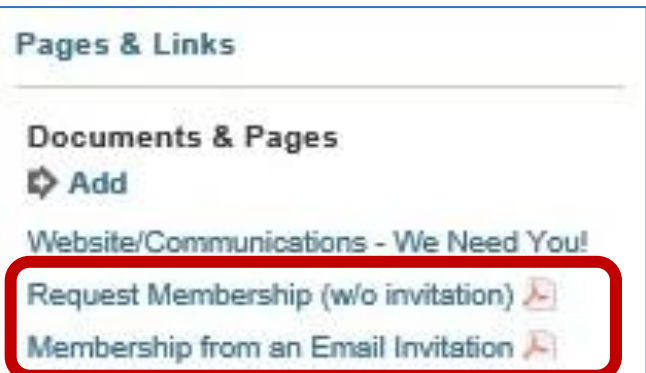
1. Those who are members of the site are able to see items that have been marked “private” (non-members cannot)
2. To submit content for the site, use the hyperlinks in the “We Need You” section
3. The site includes a “Contact List” and “Newsletter” section
4. Those who are members of the site are listed in the “Our Neighbors” section
5. The “Pages & Links” section includes documents, web pages and links to a variety of items
6. The “Calendar” section provides visibility to upcoming events
7. Click on “More...” for additional content associated with those sections



8. When one clicks on “More...” in the “Pages & Links” section, the window expands to show the available content
