Please pick up after your pet. Why???

1. Stormwater carries pet waste and other pollutants directly into waterways.
2. Animal waste adds nitrogen to the water. Excess nitrogen depletes the oxygen in water necessary for beneficial underwater grasses, wildlife and fish.
3. Animal waste may contain harmful organisms such as Giardia, Salmonella and E. coli that can be transmitted to humans and other animals by ingesting contaminated water.



□ **City News..** Brush & Bulky Item set out dates **April 5-9th.** Please keep all items off the curb until then. Anything set out early the city will pick up and charge your water bill a large fine. Notice: The City Code of Ordinances does not allow "the intentional blowing" of grass clippings into the City's drainage system (MS4) which includes city streets. When mowing, please sweep up all clippings, save our Bay.
