Jan. 26, 2018

Joe Battle (Loop 375) Widening Project

Monday through Friday (closures until further notice)

7 a.m. to 4 p.m. (at different times throughout the day and at different locations)

- Alternate north and southbound right and left lane closures along Joe Battle Boulevard between the Montana overpass and the Bob Hope overpass
- Alternate north and southbound turnaround closures along Joe Battle Boulevard between the Bob Hope overpass and the Montana overpass

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (at different times throughout the day and at different locations)

- North and southbound right lane closure on Joe Battle (Loop 375) between the Bob Hope overpass and the Montana Overpass
- Alternate north and southbound entrance and exit ramps closures along Joe Battle (Loop 375) between the Bob Hope overpass and the Montana Overpass
- These closures are necessary for guardrail and electrical work
- Please follow the detour signs in place on all projects
- All work is dependent upon weather conditions

Illumination Work

Monday, Jan. 29 through Friday, Feb. 02

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (as needed until further notice)

- Purple Heart Highway (Loop 375) northbound and southbound alternating lane closure between Railroad Drive and Montana Avenue (US 62/180)
- Crews will be installing conduits and illumination assemblies

Alameda Reconstruction Project

Thursday, Nov. 16 through Friday, Mar. 30

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (as needed until further notice)

- Alameda Avenue (SH 20) alternating lane closures westbound and eastbound will be reduced to one lane between Inglewood Road and Carnes Road
- Closures are necessary for placement of new drainage/waterline, concrete paving, sidewalk and illuminations

Fabens Bridge Project

Starting Monday, Oct. 23, at 7 a.m. through Friday, Feb. 16, 2018
(continuous complete closure)

- North Loop Road (FM 76) between Hunt Drive and Alameda Avenue (SH 20)
- Crews will be removing and replacing intersections

Striping Project

Monday, Oct. 30 through Friday, Feb. 02
8:30 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. (overnight)

- Cesar Chavez Highway (LP 375) eastbound – 2 inner left lane closures between US-54 overpass and Midway Drive
- Crews will be doing striping

Mall Braided Ramps Project

Sunday, Jan. 07 through Friday, Feb. 02 (complete closure)
9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. (overnight)

- IH-10 westbound between Yarbrough overpass to Airway overpass
- Yarbrough overpass to Airway overpass all entrance and exit ramps
- Crews will be drilling for high mast on right shoulder

Until further notice

- Gateway East reduced to one lane between Airway Boulevard and Hawkins Boulevard
- Gateway West reduced to one lane between Viscount Boulevard and Hawkins Boulevard

Closed until further notice

- IH-10 eastbound Hawkins exit ramp
- IH-10 westbound Hawkins exit ramp

TxDOT Darrington Road

Monday, Jan. 22

- Use caution at Corby Road – New 4 way stop sign in place

Deceleration Lane/Driveway Project (Note: This is not a TxDOT project.)

Expect these closures every Monday through Friday until further notice:
9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (at different times throughout the day)

- Horizon Boulevard (FM 1281) southbound right lane closure at Darrington Road
- Zaragoza Road (FM 659) northbound right lane closure between Sun Fire and Charles R. Schulte Drive
- Gateway East Boulevard right lane closure between Pendale Road and Kessler Drive

Please follow the detour signs in place on all projects. All work is dependent upon weather conditions.
