*Christmas likely brought several drones as gifts... what to know before you fly..... CLARIFICATION*

As toys get bigger and better, they tend to get cheaper. And that means many likely got a drone for Christmas. But some worry about misuse of such toys. So, here's a few things to know before you fly.

First, the FAA requires unmanned aircraft over .55 pounds and up to 55 pounds to be registered. The following website will help you to do just that:

*Posting the basic rules of those unmanned aircraft that are over the weight needing registration caused some confusion among readers. Most recreational users will not be within the weight requirement for registration. Therefore, the registration rules will not apply. Many of the same regulations for Model Aircraft apply to drones as well. In all folks, please just be courteous of your neighbors and read the laws for yourself to be sure you're enjoying your toys correctly.*

It will be left up to each owner to determine what he/she must do to comply with federal and state laws.
