

Special Emergency Meeting Called by Washington County
Purpose: Zoning Clarification

The purpose of the meeting was to clarify the zoning authority after January 1, 2017. The county has not completed the total work involved in the transition of zoning control to the townships. It is a matter of the county completing their zoning code revision, holding a public meeting, and obtaining approval from the County Board of Commissioners. The county agrees the township has/will have complete zoning control when the required county action is completed. This is expected to be done in approximately three months.

The Assistant County Attorney also asked for clarification on where/how the Aggregate Industries "loop road" fit in with the turnback of the county road to local jurisdiction. The township described Aggregate Industries commitment to cover the costs and the timing was discussed.
