

Danbury Subdivision HOA Swimming Pool Rules

Hours of Operation: Daily from 8:00am to 10:00pm Memorial Day thru Labor Day

NO LIFEGUARDS ARE ON DUTY AT ANY TIME. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

The pool may be closed without notice on occasion during those hours for the following reasons:

- Inclement weather
- Unstable or unsafe pool chemical levels
- Pool equipment breakdown
- Other

If the gate is locked then the pool is CLOSED

Under no circumstances is anyone to jump the fence or unlock the gate due to the risk of the above-mentioned hazards. If you feel the pool gate is locked in error, just contact the Trustees using one of the methods listed at the bottom to find the reason for the closure or to open the gate.

Any person under 15 years of age must be accompanied by an adult to use the pool. An adult must be specifically in charge of a minor, meaning a minor may not swim in the pool just because other adults are present, unless one of those adults has agreed to supervise that minor.

No single adult is allowed to accompany or supervise more than 5 minors unless that adult is the parent of, or related to, the minors they are supervising.

Wristband Required for Pool Entrance

- A Danbury wristband "Pool Pass" is required for entrance to the pool.
- One wristband will be issued to each household.
- This wristband must be worn by one responsible adult (over 15) from every household during their use of the pool.
- Treat the wristband as if it were a key to the pool facility.
- Any person or group attempting to use the pool without a wristband will be asked to leave; or retrieve their wristband from home no exceptions.
- Lost wristbands can be replaced for a \$10.00 fee. 2nd lost wristband \$25.00. See a Danbury Trustee for replacement.

Danbury committee members will hand out wristbands personally. If they are unable to reach you at home and you did not receive your wristband, call a Danbury Trustee

Guests

Homeowners are allowed to bring guests to the pool provided they adhere to the age requirements and all Danbury Pool Provisions and Rules.

Misuse of the wristband will result in its confiscation, thereby revoking pool privileges for the season.

More than 8 guests from one family/homeowner is considered a party.

Parties

Homeowners are welcome to host parties at the pool under the following conditions.

- Express written consent of the Trustees is required in order to host a party at the Danbury subdivision pool. Violators will have their pool privileges revoked for the season at the discretion of the trustees.
- The pool will not be closed to other homeowners, no private parties.
- There must be one adult for every 5 minors under the age of 15.
- The Head of the Pool Committee must be notified two weeks in advance of the party to avoid schedule conflicts.
- No party may exceed 30 swimmers total to avoid exceeding pool maximum occupancy.
- Homeowners hosting a pool party must clean the pool area after their party.
- Be respectful of other homeowners to not dominate the chairs, loungers, tables, space and facilities of the pool before, during and/or after your approved party.

Pool Conduct Rules

Conduct rules are posted on the pool building. The Trustees may expel those who do not follow the pool rules. Repeated problems with conduct or acts of vandalism will result in households losing their wristband and pool privileges for the season at the discretion of the trustees.

Recreational Use

The pool is for recreational use only. There shall be no business conducted at the pool by any residents. This includes but is not limited to:

- Giving private swim lessons for pay to non-residents
- Selling items such as refreshments or novelties

Pets

No pets are allowed at the pool facility. The pool facility is defined as the entire area inside the gate and fence. It is off limits to pets of any kind. Violation will result in the revocation of pool privileges at the discretion of the trustees.

Music

Music must be mutually agreed upon by the homeowners present at the pool. Music is not to be played loud enough to disturb others within the pool area unless expressly agreed upon. Please be respectful of your fellow homeowners. Violation will result in the revocation of pool privileges at the discretion of the trustees.
