

**New signage coming to alert motorists
to new crosswalk across Ranchitos Road south of Circle (south)**

Thank our neighbor William Strull for noticing and reporting on March 2, 2019 the following:

“One additional issue of concern is the absence of signage on Los Ranchitos Rd adjacent to the relatively new crosswalk at the southern of the two intersections of Los Ranchitos Rd and Circle. There is no sign advising drivers on Los Ranchitos Road of that crosswalk (as there is on the crosswalk at Ranch Road). This creates a dangerous situation when pedestrians or runners enter the crosswalk - surprising drivers who usually keep on driving through the crosswalk. I’ve narrowly missed being struck by cars on several occasions. Would the association be able to contact appropriate authorities to get the needed signage posted? If not - could you advise me as to whom to contact about this?
