

Traffic Circles on East 72nd Street

History

In the 1990s, the South Oakwood-Brookhaven spearheaded a move to make the neighborhood safer for residents, and in particular for school children walking to and from Revere Elementary. The result of that effort was the installation of the 3 traffic circles on East 72nd Street at Dobson, University and Woodlawn Avenues.

Over the years, the Circles haven't had the maintenance and "TLC" that could make them a source of beauty and neighborhood pride that they were originally intended to be.
