HURRICANE DORIAN

SEPTEMBER 6, 2019 – 11:00 a.m.

- Hurricane Dorian has moved on, and the Governor has lifted the mandatory evacuation order.
- For re-entry information you may contact Horrycounty.org at 866-246-0133.
- We have called on all of our personnel to report to the various properties to assist in evaluations and visual inspections of the storm's impact. Many staff members did evacuate as requested by the Governor, and we suspect that it may take time for them to make their way back.
- Please note that although the storm has passed, we may not be able to immediately access all areas until the areas are cleared by authorities and road blockades are removed; especially those roads effected by flooding.
- Thus far, observations have been that minimal to no damage has taken place at most of our properties.
- We expect an extremely high number of phone calls and emails. Please allow us time to get to all of the properties and organize information and status reports. As we obtain information, we will post it on our website, pinnaclemb.com. (Hurricane-related reports will not require an access code.).
- We will contact those owners directly who have water intrusion to their units.
- Email blasts specific to each property will be sent.
- We will return phone calls and emails as soon as we are able to do so.
