This vendor of Inflatable Play Structures is now list *approved* with the AV office, because they have the right insurance to cover Atchison Village.

Rental rules:

- 1) Rent ONLY from Bay Area Jump
- 2) Bring your proof of rental from Bay Area Jump to the office BEFORE bringing in the Bounce House
- 3) The AV office staff will give the member a permit to put up the Bounce House for the day/s rented. Members must post the permit at the site of the Bounce House

From AV Board Motion passed September 11, 2019

Members may choose to insure themselves through personal renter's insurance on their homes. State Farm, Geico, and other companies offer Special Day Event coverage of Bounce Houses that can be arranged for a small additional fee, if you carry their renter's insurance. Special Day Event coverage of Bounce Houses must be arranged from a week to a month in advance. Call insurance agents and ask about this coverage if you are interested. More vendors of Bounce Houses may be added to the AV approved list in the future, if they have the right insurance that AV requires.
