Constitution & By-Laws

February 16, 2018

(Includes all amendments through February 15, 2018)

Note:

This Constitution was adopted by the members at the General Meeting on November 21, 1985 and amended a number of times since then. The original signed copy as well as all adopted amendments is maintained by the Corresponding Secretary.

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Article I (Name)

Sec. 1 - The name of the organization shall be: Wakefield Taxpayers and Civic League, Inc. (organized in the year 1913 in Wakefield, Borough of the Bronx, City of New York).

Article II (Objective)

Sec. 1 - The objectives of this organization are:

- a) To safeguard the residential character of the community and to promote civic awareness and consequent activity towards the improvement of the quality of life.
- b) To promote improvements within its boundaries.
- c) To ally itself with other civic organizations when necessary.

Article III (Membership)

Sec. 1 - All persons 18 years and older, property owners, tenants, retail merchants, and public spirited citizens in Wakefield and neighboring communities are eligible for membership in this organization. Each member shall furnish the treasurer with name, mailing address, telephone number and dues.

Article IV (Dues)

Sec. 1 - Dues shall be set yearly by a two thirds vote of the Executive Board. Dues are due February 1st, payable up to the March general meeting.

Sec. 2 - Only members present and in good standing will be eligible to vote.
