*The swimming area is for the exclusive use of the residents of Liberty Creek South, Liberty Creek North and Stratford Glen. The swimming pool/area cannot be reserved or used for private parties.*

*Guests must be accompanied by a resident with a valid pool pass.*

## USER SAFETY and SANITATION RULES for the SWIMMING POOL \*

1. Children under 14 years of age and non-swimmers shall be accompanied by a responsible adult.
2. Anyone who has or has had diarrhea in the past two (2) weeks shall not use the pool.
3. Anyone who has an area of exposed sub epidermal tissue, open blisters, cuts, etc. is advised not to use the pool.
4. All persons shall take a cleansing shower before using the pool. A bather leaving the pool to use the toilet shall take another cleansing shower before returning to the pool enclosure.
5. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose and similar behavior in the pool is prohibited.
6. No running or rough play is permitted in the pool, on the runways, on diving boards, on floats, on platforms, in dressing rooms, or in showers.
7. Street clothes are not allowed in the swimming pool enclosure. Proper and modest swimming attire is required. Thong bikinis and/or street clothes such as cut-offs are NOT allowed in the pool or on the deck. Visitors or spectators in street clothes are allowed in the picnic area.
8. All diaper age children shall use plastic pants with tight fitting elastic in the legs and waist, or swim diapers.
9. Do not change diapers at poolside.
10. Adults or parents must be in the pool with their children when the children are using a flotation device.
11. Sponge balls, toys and rafts will be permitted **ONLY** with lifeguard approval.

12. Absolutely NO ALCOHOL, NO SMOKING, NO VAPING – Visible signs of intoxication/controlled substances or behavior indicative of intoxication/controlled substances will be grounds for dismissal from the premises. Infraction of these rules will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the facility.
13. Absolutely NO PETS and NO DIVING at the pool facilities or inside the pool fences. Infraction of these rules will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the facility.
14. Electronic audio devices must be played at a volume that will not disturb other pool attendees, lifeguards or nearby residents. Earphones are requested.
15. Towels MUST be used to protect the pool furniture from suntan lotions, creams and oils.
16. No towels, blankets, clothes or otherwise may be hung or displayed on the pool fence at any time.
17. Food and glass containers are NOT permitted inside the pool area. Food includes cookies, candy bars, chewing gum, candy, etc. Picnic tables are now located in the designated picnic area. The picnic area cannot be reserved.
18. Playing or “staying warm” in the showers at any time is strictly prohibited. The showers are for bathing purposes only.
19. LIFEGUARDS – A minimum of two on duty during most pool hours to maximize pool user safety in accordance with all applicable rules and regulations. Lifeguards shall monitor the number of bathers. The number of bathers must not exceed:  
1 lifeguard for up to 75 bathers 2 lifeguards for 76-150 bathers.
20. LIFEGUARDS – Will call SAFETY BREAKS - For a period of fifteen minutes each hour, the lifeguards will clear the pool for a brief safety break. At the discretion of the lifeguards, adult residents (age 18 and older) will have access to the pool during these safety breaks
21. LIFEGUARDS – Have AUTHORITY TO CLOSE THE POOL for part or all of the day when unfavorable weather conditions exist. When an unscheduled closing is necessary, the lifeguards will post the reason for the closure at the pool entrances. Closure after a fecal accident of 24 hours to allow for cleaning and decontaminations is mandated by the Marion County Board of Health.
22. LIFEGUARDS have the AUTHORITY to control any situation by asking individuals to leave the pool and recreation area or by calling Police/Security. Disciplinary action as stated in the LGA Disciplinary Policy shall be used when swimming pool users do not follow LIFEGUARD instruction per these swimming pool rules.
23. The following lifesaving equipment is available at the pool for emergency use: a ring, which can be thrown to a bather in difficulty; a life pole with a shepherds crook for reaching a struggling bather and pulling him/her to the side of the pool; a spine board with ties, cervical collar and head immobilizer for use by emergency medical or health care professionals; standard first aid kits. Bathers are not permitted to tamper with or remove such equipment from its location for any purpose other than the intended emergency use.
24. The lifeguard/manager office and breezeway apron is the designated medical emergency care area.
