

IMPORANT RULE NOTICE

Council has adopted a new policy rule pertaining to the use of trash containers for our weekly trash collection. Effective January 1, 2021, all food waste put out for trash pickup must be placed in a trash can/container with a lid.

Due to numerous incidents over the years, many plastic bags containing food waste have been ripped open by domestic and wild animals, with trash strewn all over (on a windy day, it makes it worse). In addition, we have had an incident or two of a trash bag placed in front of a car with the car then pulling out and dragging the bag down the lot, dispersing its contents all over.

Accordingly, Council has decided that cans/containers with lids can alleviate most, if not all, of the littering of trash about the grounds of BHTC.

Of course, if you have anything of a non-perishable household nature, or the like, it can be placed either in the trash receptacle or laid next to the can.

Again, this is **MANDATORY** and effective January 1st. Any bags found containing food material placed out for pickup not in the approved receptacle will be subject to warnings and, if repeated, violation fines.

Let's keep Beacon Hill Townhomes looking cleaner and help prevent Council members and others from having to pick up the strewn trash from a ripped open plastic bag.
