

## Traffic Safety Special Committee

**The MNA has formed a Special Committee to address Traffic Safety in Mariposa. There are five main concerns:**

1. Drivers running stop signs, specifically at the Mariposa Parkway and Redondo Sierra Vista and Mariposa Parkway and Unser intersections
2. Drivers speeding, specifically along the whole of Blue Grama, on Mariposa Parkway (particularly between Redondo Sierra Vista and Blue Grama), and on Redondo Sierra Vista
3. Drivers passing and drivers crossing over the double yellow no-passing stripe on Blue Grama
4. Drivers disregarding pedestrian safety at the 4-way stops and crosswalks
5. Bike lanes being impeded by parked vehicles or by pedestrians

**The Committee has developed a multi-prong approach to mitigate these problems:**

1. As a first step, we sent letters to the five companies currently building homes (Abrazo, D.R. Horton, Pulte, RayLee, and Twilight) and to the Mariposa Community Association (CCMC aka the HOA) to ask for their cooperation in helping with this problem by asking for their compliance with the existing traffic rules as the construction vehicles and subcontractors are part of the problem.
2. We sent a letter to CCMC asking them to hold the Builders accountable for the same.
3. If necessary, we will send a letter to Harvard Investments, you guessed it, asking for the same
4. We met with the City to gain an understanding of the process of traffic problem mitigation and options we may or may not have.
5. We will meet with RRPD to discuss enforcement strategies and call to their attention the most problematic areas
6. We will engage with residents directly to ensure the residents are also abiding by the traffic regulations (ie construction vehicles and subcontractors are not the only offenders)
7. We will survey the residents to see if these measures made a positive impact and if not call for additional input toward solutions.
